The SRE policy for Whitehill Primary School (The school) is based on the Healthy School Standard and Sex and Relationship Education Guidance from the DfES It has been written and developed by the Staff and Governors.

• Curriculum The SRE curriculum is taught through the PSHCE

framework and the Science KS1 & KS2 requirements of

the National Curriculum.

• **Teaching** SRE is taught discretely in Year 6. All other year groups

cover this as part of their general topic work as

appropriate. SRE is taught mainly by the classteacher. In Year 6 the School Nurse delivers part of the curriculum.

• Parents Parents have the right to withdraw their child from the

part of the SRE that is not include in the KS2 Science curriculum. Parents are offered the opportunity to view and discuss any resources used in the direct teaching of

SRE.

• Recording & Assessment There is no requirement for formal recording of SRE and

no prescribed assessments are required.

Monitoring & Evaluating
SRE will be monitored and evaluated by Senior leaders in

line with the monitoring timetable.

The School will support this policy by:

- Ensuring all staff understand and agree these principles and that they are committed to them.
- Ensuring that all staff are valued as professionals.
- Supporting staff through provision of high quality INSET and CPD opportunities.
- Encouraging collaborative working opportunities.
- Monitoring, evaluating and challenging practice.
