Parent Workshop

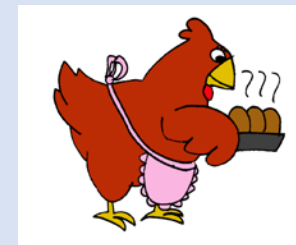
We have lots of fun activities planned for the parent workshop and look forward to seeing everyone.
