Dear Parents and Carers

Next term with the weather getting better your child may want to wear a more comfortable summer uniform.

Official Summer uniform

- Summer dress in blue or purple checks
- Grey or black trousers or shorts, pinafore or skirt
- White or pale blue polo-shirt
- Royal blue or purple sweatshirt or cardigan
- Flat, dark, sensible shoes
- Tights (optional) and socks should be white, grey or black

As the year has progressed I have seen some interesting variations in uniform and I would like to remind you that the following items should not be worn in school;

- Leggings or sports jogging bottoms (except for PE)
- Navy blue sweatshirts and cardigans (these should be Royal blue).
- High heels / wedge soled shoes or sandals
- Trainers
- Hoodies

Sorry to sound so dictatorial but the children looked really smart in September and standards have slipped recently. All staff in the school understands what is acceptable and will be able to advise you. They will also make a polite notice in the contact book if on the odd occasion your child may get it wrong.
