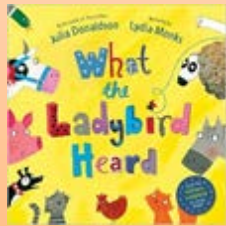

Reception Classes

I know that many of you are looking forward to your children starting Reception in September. Please be aware that there are many contributing factors when deciding which classes children will be allocated. There must be a balance of gender and age amongst other things.

Mrs French (Foundation Stage Leader) will be getting to know the children over the next few weeks to help inform class allocation. As you can appreciate we currently have 4 Nursery classes and there will also be many other new children starting at Whitehill Primary all of whom will need to be mixed into the 3 Reception classes so requests cannot be met.
