Dear Parents and Carers

- Royal blue (not navy blue) or purple sweatshirt or cardigan
- Summer dress in blue or purple checks or stripes to match cardigan colours
- Flat, dark, sensible shoes
- Tights and socks in white, grey or black

Many of you will be beneficiaries of the voucher I sent home that can be reimbursed for uniform if your child is in receipt of free school meals.
