Dear Parents and Carers

During terms 5 and 6, year 2 teachers are required to make judgements on the levels that the children are working at in Reading, Writing, Maths and Science. These Teacher Assessments are then reported to the Standards and Testing Agency where the data is used to evaluate school standards.

Teacher Assessments are formed from a range of sources including in-class assessments, internal tests and National Tests. The National Tests are used to confirm the teacher's judgements and are not reported as a separate grade. The children in year 2 have been undertaking sample tests since the start of the year, I do not expect them to even notice that they have undertaken a National Test. The tests will be done during the week of 21st May, if for any reason you know that your child will be absent from school that week please let us know asap so that other arrangements can be made.

All adults endeavour to make this a stress free process and parents should not worry about how their children perform.

We will report the outcomes of the Teacher Assessments to all parents in due course.
