We will also continue to embed partitioning, addition and subtraction. Please encourage your children to use and show the skills they have been learning within the class in their home-learning books.

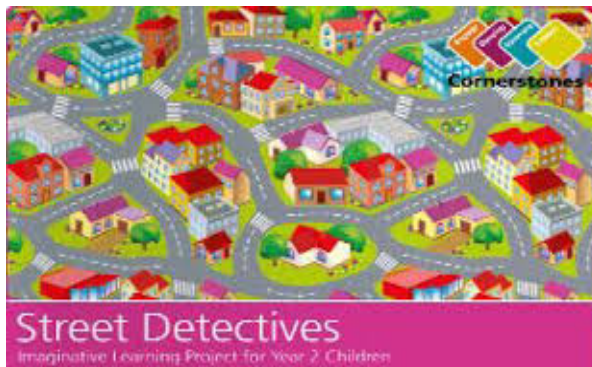
Important Information

Our topic this term is '**Street Detectives**'.

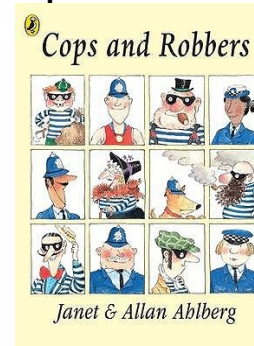
Topic
