Maths

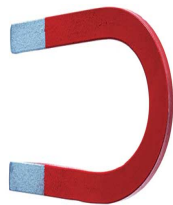
- Our focus this term in maths is column subtraction, using the inverse and multiplication and division. This will include learning about:
