Our indoor PE is dance and the outdoor PE is football.

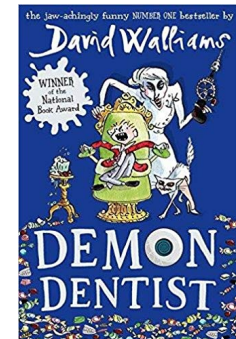
RE
