


Nursery Learning Letter

This Week

This week we have read the story 'The Three Little Pigs'. We have enjoyed;

- Making and tasting porridge with different toppings.
- Drawing pictures of the story in a group story map.
- Retelling the story using props and puppets.
 - Counting spoonfuls of porridge and recognising numbers to 10.
- Sorting bears by size and colour.
- Building a bear cave using large construction crates.
