Maths

In maths we will be studying units of measure, perimeter area and volume and ratio.

We will look at how to measure accurately and how to convert between different units of measure.

We will study how to find the perimeter, area and volume of a variety of different shapes and we will look at the links between them.

In our study of ratio, we will look at comparing amounts and comparing numbers. We will be applying this to a practical context.

In this term we will be focusing on preparing for our **SATS** and taking part in **SATS** revision.

Science

We will be developing our scientific investigative skills, especially evaluating experiments, through our science topic of changing states.

RE

We will be learning about eternity, what it is and what the different religions think about eternity.

English

We will be reading the book 'Wolf Brother' by Michelle Paver. This book follows the story of the listener, a lost boy, alone in a forest, who must fight the demon bear and save the world with only his spirit guide to help him.

In writing, we will focus on sentence structure and applying this to narratives. We will look at descriptive writing and how to convey character through the use of speech. The children will even get the chance to create their own characters which we will use to dip in and out of the story and make challenging decisions.
