Reading Volunteers

As I'm sure you are aware, at Whitehill Primary School we place an emphasis on regular reading practice. Reading to an adult and discussing books is an extremely important part of learning to read and we like to provide as many opportunities as possible for children to do this.

We would like to recruit some parent, carer and grandparent volunteers to come into school and work with children in Key stage One (Years 1 and 2), hearing them read and talking about the books. If you could spare an hour or so each week to do this, we would love to hear from you.

Typically, we would like help changing reading books for the whole class and working one-to-one with children reading with them. This would be from 13:10 until 15:00. An initial training session will be provided.

According to school policy, volunteers do not work in the same class as their children. Volunteers will also be required to undertake a DBS (criminal record check) and to fill in one or two additional forms for safeguarding reasons.
