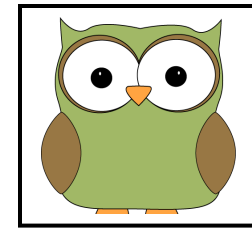


# Nursery Learning Letter

We will be reading:

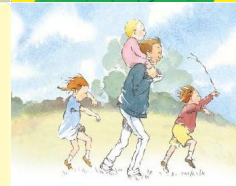
- What the ladybird heard
