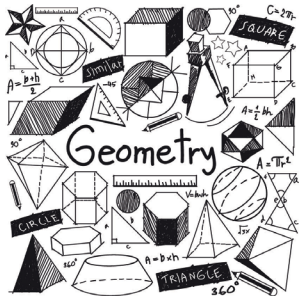
Year 5 Learning Letter

World's Big Questions

Our topic this term is 'Off With Her Head!' This topic is based around The Tudors. We will also look at some of Shakespeare's work.

Science

Do you remember us telling you that we would be learning about materials in term 3 and then changing the plans? Well we are definitely going to be learning about materials this term.

We will explore the three states of matter; mixing and separating and the possibility of reversible and irreversible changes.
