



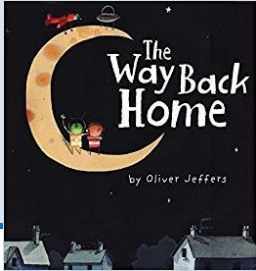
Reception Learning Letter
