PE

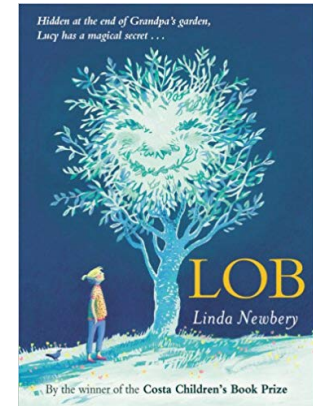
Our indoor PE is dodgeball and the outdoor PE is athletics. We will be getting ready for Sports Day.
